WHEREAS Rule 2073.5 of the California Rules of Court has been repealed and replaced by Rule 2073(e) of those Rules, effective January 1, 2005; and

WHEREAS this Court has issued an Order dated March 15, 2004 permitting certain remote electronic access to Court records in this case, pursuant to the authority of Rule 2073.5; and

WHEREAS Rule 2073(e)(3) of the California Rules of Court provides that, following five days notice posted on the Court's website, this Court may issue an order permitting remote electronic access to certain public court records in extraordinary criminal cases; and

WHEREAS the number of requests for access to documents in this case is or is expected to be extraordinarily high, and responding to such requests would significantly burden the operations of the Court; and

WHEREAS this Court has considered all factors specified as relevant for consideration by subsection Rule 2073(e)(1) of the California Rules of Court; and required notice of proposed issuance of this Order having been posted on the Court's website on December 23, 2004;

## NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. That the Order Permitting Remote Electronic Access to Public Court Records in this case issued by this Court on March 15, 2004, is vacated, effective on the date of this Order; and
- 2. That remote electronic access to all documents officially filed with the Court in this case be made available on an appropriate Court electronic public access website; with the exception of any records that are ordered sealed or filed in a Confidential Court file and any court reporter transcripts of Court proceedings; and
- 3. That all documents posted pursuant to this order be redacted, to the extent feasible, as to all of the information specified by Rule 2073(e)(2) of the California Rules of Court; and
- 4. That the parties in this case may be ordered to file both original unredacted versions and redacted versions of the documents to be posted on the Court's website, as determined by and in the discretion of the trial judge assigned to this case.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that redaction of information required by this Order does not apply to any document in the original Court file; and that redaction applies only to documents that are made available by remote electronic access as provided herein.
